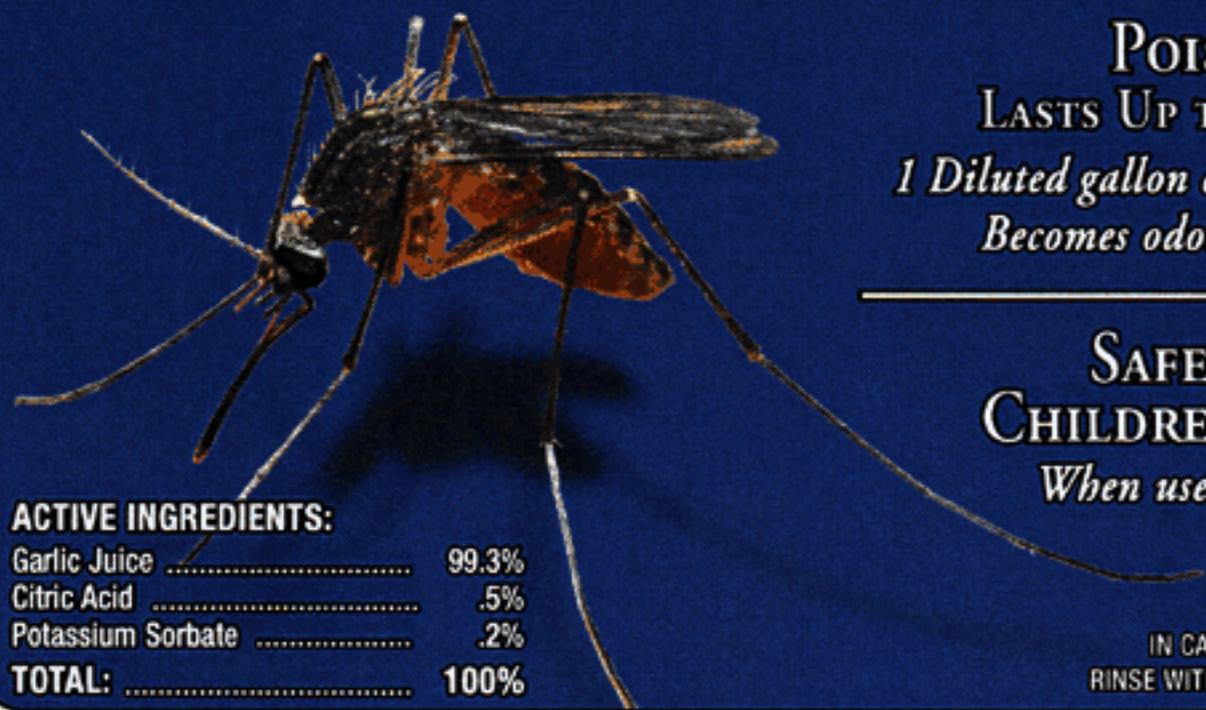

**PRODUCT INFORMATION:** Product, except for preservative, is all garlic juice. It is designed to be diluted in water and sprayed on plants, grass, shrubs, flowers, ornamentals, trees, vines and in any standing water in the area, including water under porches and decks.

Product normally becomes odorless in less than an hour. Used as directed, the product does not harm any vegetation, nor does it impart garlic flavor or taste to food plants.

Mosquito Barrier® may be used alone, in water or mixed with surfactants and stickers such as, vegetable oils, fish oils and insecticidal soaps. It may, if desired, be mixed with pesticides (where permitted).

## **DIRECTIONS**

**MIXING DIRECTIONS:** Shake container or stir contents thoroughly before mixing. Mix one gallon of Mosquito Barrier® into 99 parts of water to make 100 total gallons.

**MIXING NOTE:** If water is extremely hard and Mosquito Barrier® shows signs of not mixing well, you may add an emulsifier such as, insecticidal soap (No more than 1 % of total mix) to aid in making homogeneous solution.

### **APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:**

**TIMING:** Spray between the hours of 8AM and 11AM or late in the afternoon such as 5PM-8PM. Avoid spraying in heat of the day. Do not spray on windy days, or if rain is expected within 48 hours.

**AREAS TO BE SPRAYED:** Use a heavy mist spray and spray all grass, ornamentals, flowers, vegetable areas, into trees and up enough into trees to cover lower limbs. Spray any standing water, under porches and banks of any streams or creeks.

Be sure to cover foliage completely including underside of leaves.

**ALSO REPELS:** Armadillos, Deer, Field Mice, Fleas, Geese, Gnats, Rabbits and Ticks.

## **DIRECTIONS FOR PROFESSIONAL LANDSCAPERS / APPLICATORS**

**LARGE TANK MIXES:** Make every attempt not to use hard water. If hard water is used or must be used, then it is best to add an approved emulsifier such as, an insecticidal soap to help the garlic mix with water for a uniform mixture. Under no circumstances use any insecticidal soap concentration greater than 1% of the total spray volume.

Mix 1 gallon of Mosquito Barrier® to each 99 gallons of water. For smaller mixes, if using a canister sprayer, mix 3 tablespoons of Mosquito Barrier® to each gallon of water. If adding insecticidal soap, also mix in no more than 2 tablespoons per gallon.

Do not let mixture stand in tank overnight.

**SAFE TO USE:** Mosquito Barrier® will not harm any plants when used as directed.

**PREFERRED OILS TO USE AS STICKERS:** To help Mosquito Barrier® stick in place on plants, preferred oils are: Canola Oil, Soybean Oil, Cotton Seed Oil. Mix oils into water at same ratio as Mosquito Barrier® – one gallon of oil to 99 gallons of water.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store unused Mosquito Barrier® in cool dry place and when empty, rinse and present for recycling.
